Applying Exponent Rules

Exponent of 0
 $4^0 = 1$
A base with an exponent of 0 is always equal to 1.

Exponent of Quotients
 $\frac{4^6}{4^5} = 4^1 = 4$
When dividing exponential terms with the same base, subtract the powers.

Negative Exponents
 $2^{-6} = \frac{1}{2^6} = \frac{1}{64}$

Exponent of Products
 $4^4 \times 4^2 = 4^6$
When multiplying exponential terms with the same base, add the powers.

Exponent of Powers
 $(2^2)^{-3} = 2^{-6}$
When a power is raised to another power,

a^n ← Exponent Base
An exponent refers to the number of times a term is multiplied by itself.
For e.g.
 $a \times a \times a = a^3$

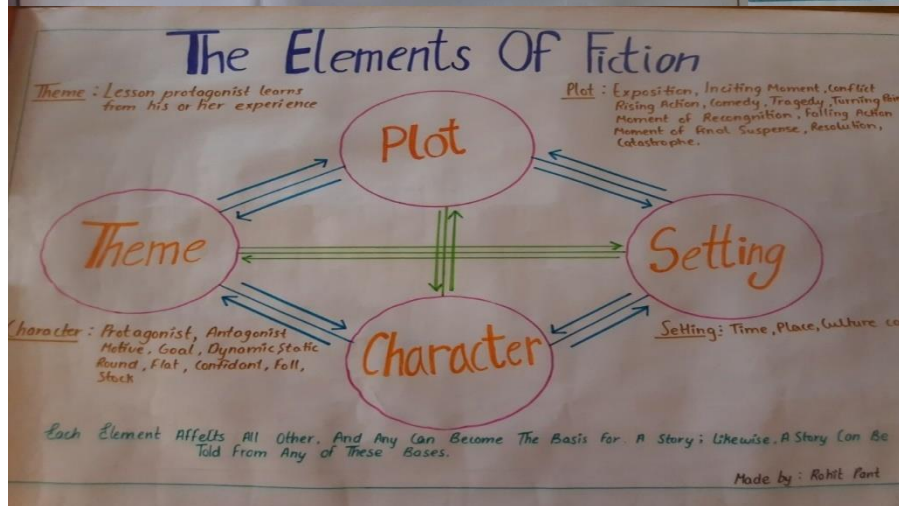
Elements of Drama

- SCRIPT**: The Script is the written word for the actors.
- ACTORS**: The actors are the characters in a drama.
- ACTS**: The acts are the chapters of drama.
- TREATER**: The theater is the place where a drama is performed.
- DIALOGUE**: The dialogue is what the actors say in drama.
- SCENES**: The scenes in a drama show the changes in settings over time.
- PROPS**: The things in a drama are tools used to bring it to life.

HISTORY OF ENGLISH LITERATURE

- 700-1000** (Old English Literature): The oldest English literature was Beowulf by an unknown poet. The poem paints a picture of the old Germanic life.
- 1100-1500** (Medieval): In this period there was the famous Geoffrey Chaucer who was the father of poetry with his unfinished collection of stories by a group of pilgrims while travelling. The Canterbury Tales (1387-1400) is another work.
- 1500-1600** (Renaissance): This period focuses on the individual concern with the fullest possible cultivation of human potential. Names and Juliet (1597).
- 1700-1800** (Enlightenment): Also known as age of reason emphasized reason and logic over religious and political orders encouraging new ideas and debated everything and criticism from the common people. Enlightenment (1788) by Rousseau.
- 1798-1870** (Romantic Period): Was an artistic movement that valued imagination and feelings over intellect and reasoning. Was revolt against aristocratic, social and political norms of the previous period.
- 1830-1860** (Transcendental Movement): This movement was a religious concept rooted in the areas of American Democracy revolt against the conservative Unitarian Church examples of this are: Walden (1854) and The American Scholar (1837).
- 1837-1901** (Victorian period): Victorian age can be said to be the age of critical realism. British morality of the early and mid-Victoria period was reflected in novels where society effects on individuals are analyzed. Some of the writers are: Emily Bronte (Jane and Wuthers (1855)), George Eliot (Silas Marner (1871)).
